*Participating parishioners who attend Mass each Sunday and contribute at least \$300.00 from January 1, 2007 through December 31, 2007 will receive \$500. 00 less towards their tuition as is reflected in the different tuition totals.

Tuition may be paid either in one payment by September 15, 2008 or in ten payments payable by the 10th of each month from July through April.

Every St. Genevieve School family is also required to devote a minimum of forty(40) hours of service to the School/Parish or pay a \$400 fee, which is the equivalent of \$10 per hour. Each family should spend at least ten (10) hours of their 40 mandatory service hours to assist in the Parish Fiesta. Service hours should be completed on or before May 31st. Otherwise, \$15. Per hour will be charged for your remaining service hours.

Schedule of Fees

Non-refundable Screening Fee

New students must pay a \$30 non-refundable screening fee at the time of screening.

Grades K-8 Annual Fee

An Annual Fee of \$300 per student in Grades K through 8 is due payable on or before April 30th. This amount becomes non-refundable after July 1st.

Fee For Late Tuition Payments

A late fee of \$25 will be charged for any tuition payment not received by the end of the current month.

Returned Check Fee

In event that a check is returned, SGS will charge will charge a fee of \$25 for each check.

Fundraising Program

The Archdiocese of Los Angeles strongly encourages all elementary schools to be self-supporting. We are dedicated to providing our students with the spiritual, academic, and technological resources that will prepare them for the future. St. Genevieve School remains committed to keeping a tuition schedule that is reasonable for families. We ask that each family participate in our fundraising programs.

There are several ways this can be done. Each family must contribute the following: \$200 for one child, \$250 for two, \$300 for three and \$350 for four or more. This is a summary of our Fundraising Program:

Each \$50.00 box you sell will credit your Fundraising Fee \$25.00. You may sell as many as you wish or you may sell none. A letter asking for how many boxes you wish to sell will go out sometime in January.

Eighth graders who participate in Corozon House Build will have \$50.00 deducted from their fundraising fee.

- **GOLF TOURNAMENT**

The school will be holding a Golf Tournament each spring. Parents may buy tickets for this event and this amount will be credited towards your Fundraising Fee 50%.
